Dagli anfibi all'Homo Sapiens, il cervello dei vertebrati si è sempre prestato a un miglioramento, a un cambiamento, mentre negli invertebrati è nato così perfetto da non entrare nel gioco delle mutazioni, tanto è vero che i trilobiti vissuti centinaia di milioni di anni fa non sono essenzialmente diversi dagli insetti, dagli artropodi di oggi. Ecco perché l'imperfezione «merita un elogio».

In Praise Of Imperfe Rita Levi-Montalcini, 1988-05-08 The autobiography of Levi-Montalcini, who won the Nobel Prize for Medicine in 1986. Born in Torino into a middle-class Jewish family, she experienced the rise of fascism and antisemitism in the 1930s-40s (discussed on pp. 73-105). After the promulgation of the racial laws in 1938, it was impossible for her to pursue research at the Neurological Clinic and she continued her work in private. She survived the war hiding in a small town in Italy and later emigrated to the United States.

Riuscì a far prevalere le sue ragioni sulle aspettative tradizionali del padre e ad iscriversi alla Facoltà di Medicina, continuando a studiare il sistema nervoso anche dopo la laurea. Ebraica nell'Italia fascista, fu sospesa dalla professione con la promulgazione delle discriminatorie leggi razziali e in seguito, perseguitata dal Nazismo, riuscì a lavorare clandestinamente in un laboratorio improvvisato che aveva predisposto nella casa dei suoi, in camera da letto. Il coraggio di Rita che accettò una borsa di studio per gli USA senza conoscere la lingua

trasformò il suo soggiorno americano di pochi mesi in una permanenza di trentatré anni particolarmente proficui. Quando all'età di settantasette anni Rita vinse, con Stanley Cohen, il Premio Nobel per la scoperta del NGF o Fattore di Crescita Nervoso - attualmente utilizzato anche per cercare di curare malattie come Alzheimer e Parkinson - iniziò per lei una nuova vita. Nei vent'anni successivi, da vera ambasciatrice della scienza e dell'umanesimo filantropico, realizzò più di quanto riesca alla maggior parte delle persone in un'intera esistenza.
